

Dyno Stagebox Preamp Rhodes Suitcase Application Notes



The Dyno Stagebox Preamp should be connected as an "Effects" or "Accessory" would be connected.

In the case of a Suitcase model, that means running an instrument cable from "Accessory 1" jack on the Rhodes piano to the Dyno Stagebox "Input", and another instrument cable from the Dyno Stagebox "Output" to the "Accessory 2" jack on the Rhodes piano. (See Illustration)

Be certain to keep the Output Level control, located on the side of the Dyno Stagebox Preamp at a low setting so it doesn't overdrive the Suitcase's built in Preamp's input.

NOTES:

- The Dyno Stagebox Preamp, when connected in this manner, is located between the piano's pickups and the input of the built in preamp.
- "Janus" Preamp Control Panel shown. "Peterson" Preamp Control Panel, though with different control, has the same Accessory jacks and is connected in the same manner.
